**Red River
International Bike Tour
June 18-22, 2007**

The first-ever Red River International Bike Tour (RRIBT) is a five-day, 300 plus-mile bike tour that begins in the heart of the Red River Valley in East Grand Forks, Minn., winds its way up on the North Dakota side across the border into Canada, and then circles back through Minnesota. Riders will enjoy rolling valley terrain and the beautiful hills of the Pembina Gorge, stopping in communities along the way for refreshment, entertainment and encouragement.

The ride includes all the amenities of camping facilities, showers, route maps and road markings, aid stations every 15 to 25 miles, bicycle repair services, arranged meals in each community, baggage transport and medical support.

Overnights will be spent in beautiful, well-maintained state parks and communities throughout the area, providing riders with a peaceful rest at the end of each day.

Anyone wishing to do a Century Loop can ride an extra 26 miles on Day 2.

Riders have the option on Day 3 of crossing the border into Canada or staying in the United States.
