CVB Awards Special Event Funding Grants

Grand Forks, ND (May 4, 2009) - The Greater Grand Forks Convention & Visitors Bureau (CVB) and the Forks Area Sports Association (FASA), a division of the CVB, are pleased to announce nine organizations planning upcoming events were recently awarded grants from the Special Event Funding Program. This program was designed to help support conventions, athletic tournaments and events that attract out-of-town participants and have an economic impact on the community.

The following events were awarded funds:

- Northern Hockey Unlimited for the Ice Palace Cup Tournaments - \$3,000
- Greater Grand Forks Soccer Club for the 2009 Grand Cities Soccer Tournament - \$1,250 plus the FASA BreakAway Players' Lounge
- Crimson Creek Players for "Bat Boy" and "Hair" - \$5,000
- Sertoma for the 4th of July Festival - \$2,000 in advertising
- Red River Valley YMCA Wahoos for the 2009 Central Zone Swimming Championship Meet - \$3,000
- Grand Forks Historical Society for Chautauqua - \$1,500
- Special Olympics of ND for the 2009 State Soccer & Bocce Tournament - \$500 plus the FASA BreakAway Players' Lounge
- Grand Forks Herald for the 2009 Jason Stadstad Hockey Classic - \$500 plus the FASA BreakAway Players' Lounge
- Lake Agassiz Reading Council for the 2010 State Reading Conference - \$1,500

Applications are reviewed on a quarterly basis. Each quarter the Special Events Funding Committee, made up of two CVB board members and the executive director, reviews the submissions and awards funds. The next deadline for applications is July 31, 2009.

The CVB began this program in 2002, and already in 2009 has awarded over \$40,000 for events that have either occurred in Greater Grand Forks or will be occurring in the future. In addition to the weight placed on attracting visitors and generating economic impact, the CVB also places emphasis on multiple day events, first time events and those that attain sponsorships from additional sources.

“The CVB is pleased to be able to provide financial support for events in addition to our promotional assistance”, said Julie Rygg, CVB Executive Director. “If we want to continue to grow as a destination community our efforts to aid those groups striving to bring visitors to Greater Grand Forks are crucial.”
